



2009 STEEL CITY TACTICAL CARBINE CHAMPIONSHIP



MATCH INFORMATION

The 2009 Steel City Tactical Carbine Championship match will be held on Saturday, May 30th and Sunday, May 31st. The match will have a one day format; the participant may choose to shoot on either Saturday or Sunday. The match will consist of 7 scenario based stages. Distances of shots will be from up close (house clearing) type stages to long shots on steel flash targets out to 250-300yds. Plan on firing 175-200 rounds and spending most of the day at the range. It'll be a full day of shooting.

Rules and scoring will be consistent with standard Steel City Tactical Carbine Match rules and may be viewed on the Steel City website. IPSC cardboard targets are the standard for paper targets and various reactive steel targets are used for the long range engagements. Some stages may include special or bonus targets. An explanation of how to neutralize these targets will be covered in the course description on those stages.

The match fee for this year's "Championship" match is slightly higher than last year's (\$60 vs \$50). The Steel City Range BOD has kindly agreed to allow us to use more of the deeper shooting bays which will make for more interesting stages and, hopefully, a better match. A t-shirt will be given to all pre-registered shooters. As match director, my goal is to always keep this match affordable to anyone who wants to shoot it.

Please consider this to be a "Trophy Match". Plaque trophies will be awarded for 1st through 3rd place in each category. Tactical Optics will have trophies awarded for 1st through 5th place due to the large number of participants in this category. In 2008, we had many generous sponsors who donated lots of nice prizes for us to give away. We are hopeful that we'll have sufficient prizes this year to award something nice to the winners of each category. The rest of the prizes will be raffled off by random drawing. This will be totally dependent on participation of the sponsors. I'll have a better idea of what we can do in this area as we get closer to match time and I will keep registered shooters apprised of what we have to work with regarding prizes and distribution. The bottom line is, please plan to shoot this match for the challenge and enjoyment. Please view any prizes and shooter's bag goodies as nice "extras".

Last year's match filled up 5-6 weeks out, so if you would like to shoot, please don't wait too long to send in your application. We'll plan on 75-80 shooters max each day and I suspect that Saturday will be the most popular of the two days. Refunds will be permitted for cancellations prior to May 1st.

Lastly, if you're interested in RO'ing the match, please let me know. We'll try to have 2-3 RO's on each stage as we did last year to assure things run smoothly. We try to take good care of our RO's.
